Description: The Friends of the Library are now accepting entries for *A is for Art, B is for Books, C is for Celebration*, an exhibition of visual art incorporating words, letters and/or text. Work will be selected by a blind jury of distinguished arts professionals.

A is for Art, B is for Books, C is for Celebration is open to any Ohio visual artist working in any mediums. Both two and three dimensional works will be accepted and must not exceed 5' by 5'. Two-dimensional work must be wired and ready to hang on wall. Two-dimensional work is not to exceed weight limit of 25 pounds each. Work must be dry. *Applying artists must have a Columbus Metropolitan Library card and be registered with the Ohio Online Visual Artist Registry. This juried exhibition is open to all living Ohio residents 18 years of age or older. Work must be original and executed within the past three years. OAC and CML employees are not eligible to compete.

Up to 26 pieces will be selected for this three month exhibition. The exhibition dates are April 21 through July 28, 2007. An award of \$750 will be made for first place, and additional recognition will be provided to artists

receiving honorable mention. Selected artists will be notified at the beginning of April.

An opening reception and library centennial celebration is being held April 28, 2007. Sue Grafton, the author of the *A is for Alibi* alphabet mystery series, will be the keynote speaker at the centennial celebration; thus the tie to *A is for Art, B is for Books, C is for Celebration!*
